## OBJECTIVES AND BACKGROUND

The system of the Italian welfare has recently been the subject of two significant new legislations. In June of 2016 it was presented to the Senate the Draft Law "for the recognition and appreciation of the family caregiver", and in the same month the Law "After Us" was approved (LN112 / 2016), "Provisions on assistance for persons with severe disabilities without family support".

Innovations, cultural changes and the potential of social and economic benefits that ensue from these two laws (one is at the proposal stage) invite, as a first step, to a joint reflection between local, national and European actors.

The event is not dedicated to the technical aspects of the "After us" law, but it intends to create an opportunity for interaction between: existing Italian experiences of **autonomous life projects for people with disabilities** (including mild and severe-medium), and **European experiences** in the field.

This exchange of good practices focuses on the role of families, the innovation in housing proposals, the legal aspects and the perspectives for a sustainable future - both economically and as a collaborative exercise between the disabled person / family / institutions and the third sector.

### AIRPORTS

The closest and more convenient Airport from Padova is [Venice Marco Polo](#).

Alternatively, there is [Venice Treviso](#), which is a little less direct to reach from Padova. However, many low cost airlines fly to Treviso.

### From [Venice Marco Polo](#) to [Padova Central Station](#) by shuttle bus

Once you land at Venice Marco Polo, the bus and coach stops will be just outside the arrivals hall. Before you leave the airport building, however, you should purchase your coach ticket.

When you walk past the sliding doors into the arrivals hall, on your left you will find different counters – car rental, tourist information and ticket offices. Look for the [ATVO ticket counter](#). There, ask for a one way or a return ticket to Padova Trainstation (the price is €8,50 each way). Here is the schedule on the way TO and FROM Padova.

### RAILWAY STATION

- from the railway and bus station: take bus no. 24 (no. 43 on public holidays) stop in Via S. Maria in Vanzo or take the Metrobus direction Guizza Terminal South stop Diaz; from the Highway: exit Padova Ovest.
