Three modules:

- ▶ Module 1: Understanding the phenomenon of young carers in school context
- ▶ Module 2: Supporting young carers in schools: international experiences
- ▶ Module 3: Supporting young carers in schools: experiences and tools in [country] - *this module is not available in English*

Each module is a mix of theoretical information and practical activities (case-study, videos etc.)

At the end of each module a self-assessment test is available

GOALS OF THE TRAINING

Short term

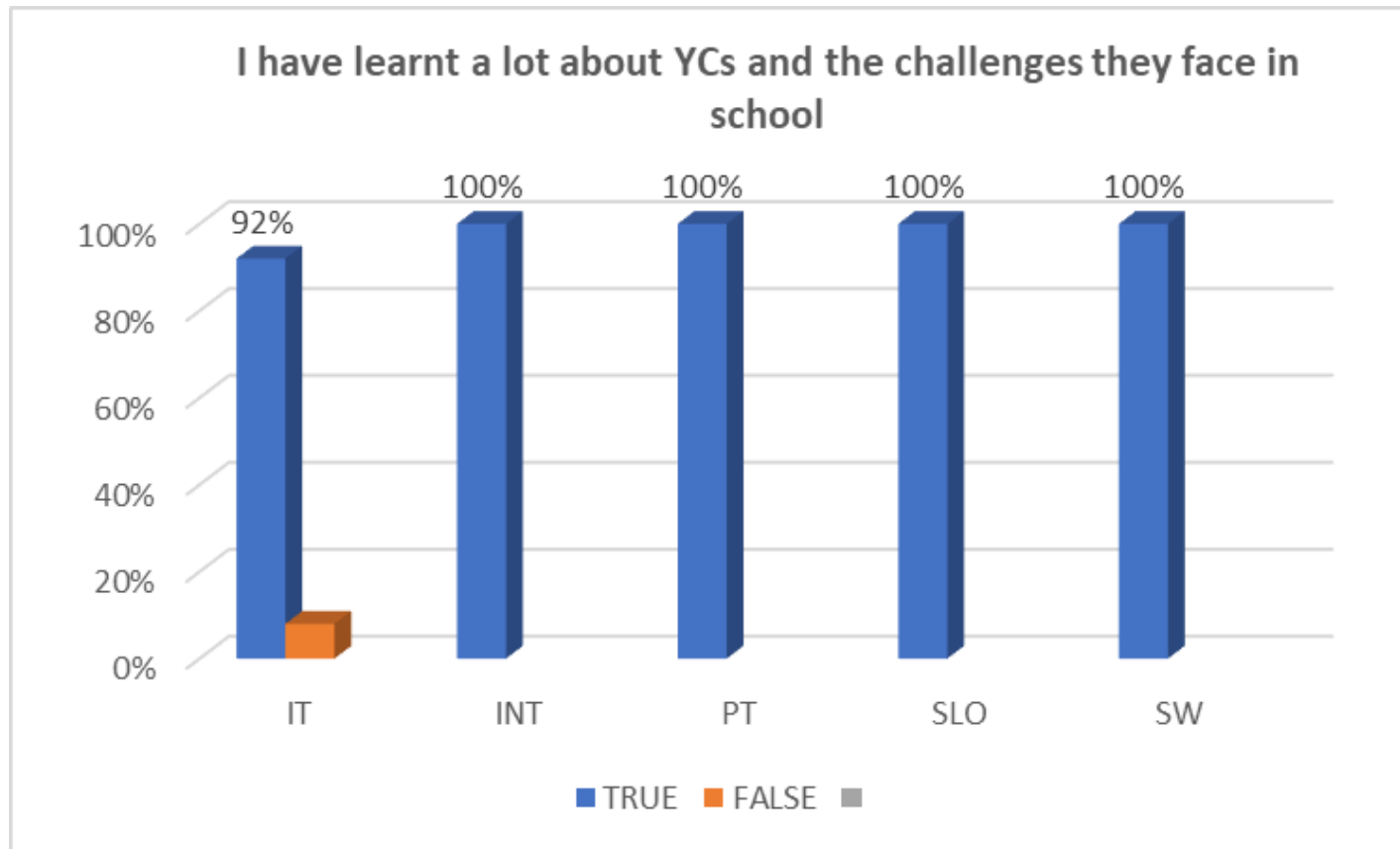
- ▶ Increasing awareness among teachers and school staff concerning the needs of young carers
- ▶ Strengthening the skills of teachers and school staff concerning the identification and the support of young carers in educational contexts

Medium - long term

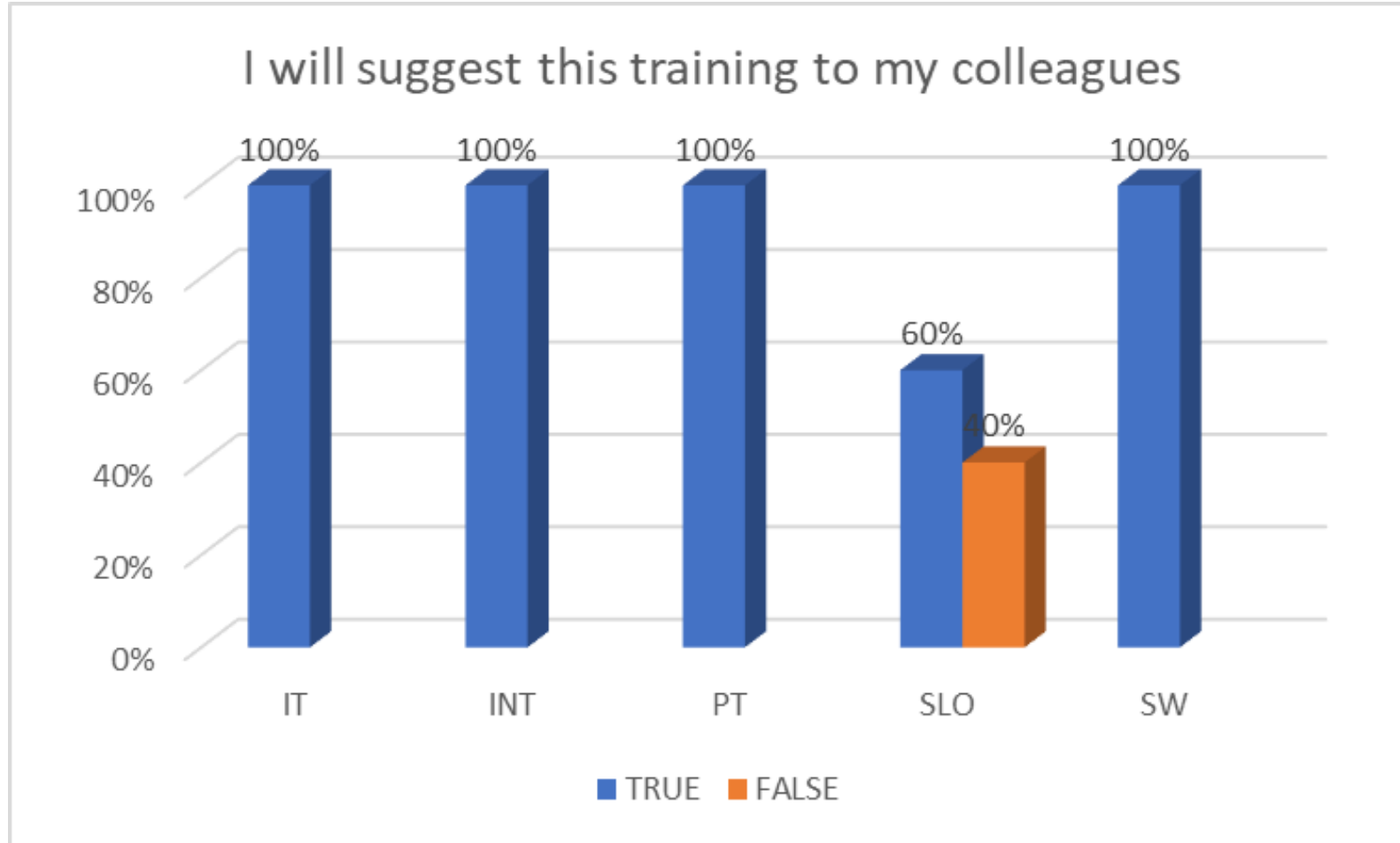
- ▶ Prevention of drop-outs within young carers and promotion of better school attainment
- ▶ Reduction of the risk of social exclusion, solitude and stigma among young carers

RESULTS FROM THE PILOTING (1/3)

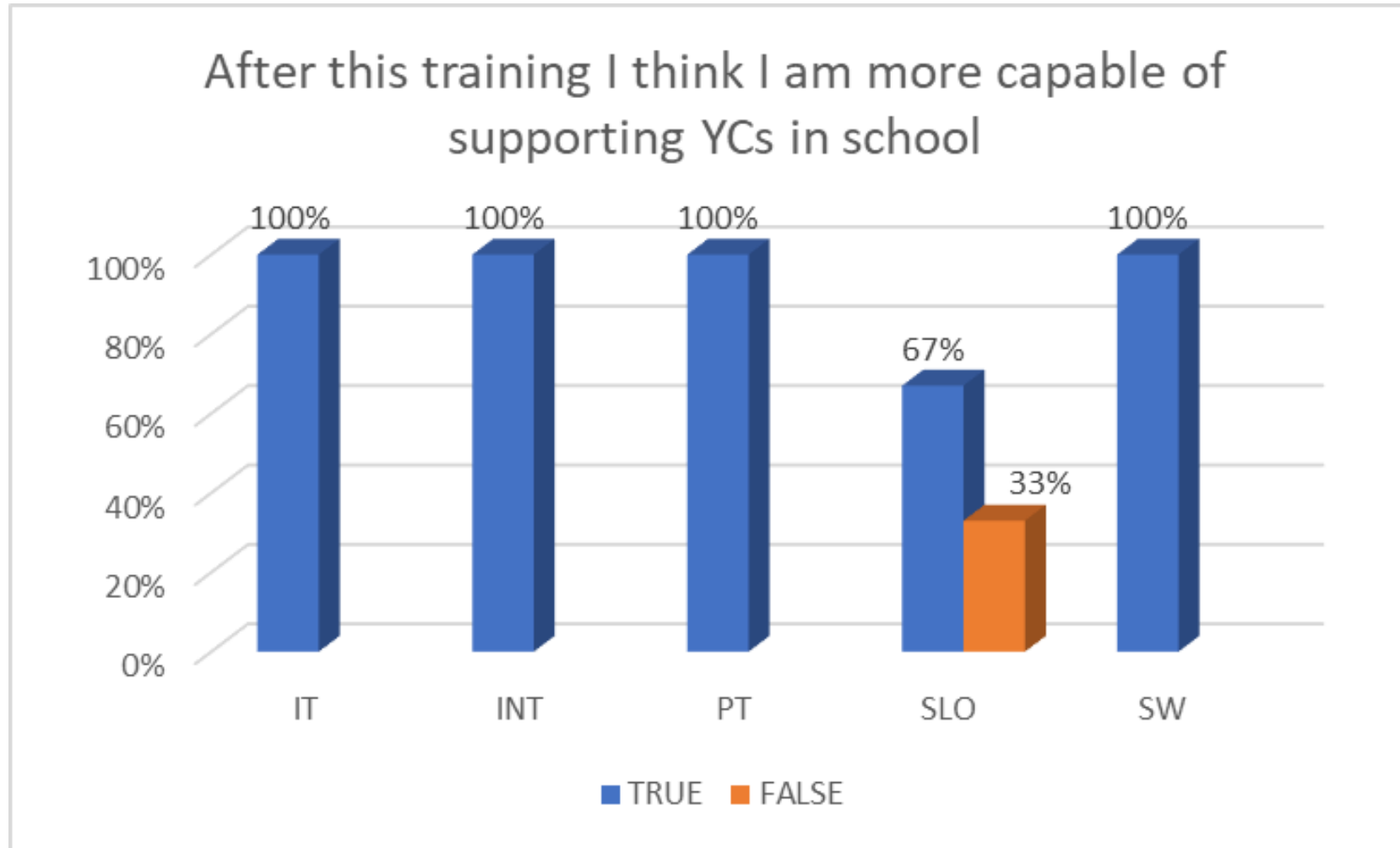
- ▶ 72 registered users
